The first day of school for the 2025-2026 school year is <u>August 25, 2025</u> for grades K through 5<sup>th</sup> (Kinder students will have a 12:00 dismissal August 25- 29, 2025)

\*As a reminder, we must have all required paperwork in order for your child to enroll.

## **School hours:**

School gates open every day at 7:45 am with school starting officially at 8:15 am. The school day ends at 2:54pm. No students will be allowed in the building before 7:45 am. Also, the main office will be open to parents at 8:15 am with the exception of pre-scheduled meetings.

## **Breakfast:**

Breakfast is still provided to every student. Breakfast will take place BEFORE instructional hours from 7:45 am to 8:10 am. Students will enter through the side gate on Howard street for morning breakfast. Breakfast service will stop at 8:10 am with no exceptions. Students are not permitted on the playground without adult supervision before 8:00 am.

## Arrival:

- Grades PreK-5 will start their day in the schoolyard for admissions.
- **Bus Riders** and students in our AS Program will enter the building through the side gate facing Howard street.
- ★ All students should be in their correct locations by 8:10 am, to join their teachers for admissions promptly at 8:15am.

Moffet Staff will be present and visible to escort or direct students to their assigned admission location. Please see admission and dismissal policy in the student handbook for more details. Student handbooks are available on our website. A copy will also be sent home the first week of school.



#### Dismissal:

- Students attending an afterschool program will be escorted to their assigned location by a member of the afterschool program.
- Please communicate our dismissal procedures to your child's After School Programs if it is an outside agency.
- Grades K-5 will dismiss in the schoolyard. Please meet your scholar in the area marked with their classroom number.

## **Attendance Matters!**

Attendance matters for doing well in school starting in Kindergarten. Absences can add up before you know it! As a parent, you are responsible for making sure your child develops the habit of regular attendance. If you are facing any challenges, seek out support from the school and community. We are here to help. Your children can suffer academically if they miss more than 16 school days. That can be just one day every two weeks, and that can happen before you know it. When students are in school, we can ensure they are learning. At Moffet we want every student to attend school 90% of the time which means a student cannot be absent more than 18 times in the school year. "Less Than Eighteen You're on Green". Please, Please, Please, send in an absence note upon return. Please include the absence note in your scholar's homework folder so the teacher can send it to the main office.

## **Uniforms:**

Here are details about the required school uniform and where you can purchase the items. Our tops are White, Gray, or Red, and our bottoms are Blue or Gray.
